VISIT TO PATTADAKAL, BADAMI CAVES AND TEMPLES

70 KILOMETERS FROM HUBLI

The Badami Caves are one of the best-kept connections to 6th century India. In addition, the temples in the area are considered to be some of the most architecturally advanced of India. The town of Pattadakal was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987.
